Culture of Safety Overview

- Scott Schifsky
- **Incident Review Context:** Examines how organizations typically respond to incidents and their impact on workplace culture.
- **Using Safety Science to Support Work:** Explores how a shift in approach can enhance learning and system improvement.
- Common Pitfalls in Incident Reviews:
 - Oversimplifying causation by assuming a single cause.
 - o Focusing on individual blame rather than systemic issues.
 - Using counterfactuals that limit learning.
 - Over-relying on additional training, forms, and policies as solutions.

Systems Thinking Approach:

- Encourages understanding the interactions of system components rather than isolating issues.
- Emphasizes learning from workers and their experiences.
- Moves beyond individual decisions to examine broader influencing factors.

• Incident Review Approach:

- Recognizing that all decisions make sense in context.
- o Identifying human, conditional, and control factors that shape decisions.
- Avoiding language that assigns blame or implies judgment.
- Adopting the "5 A's of Incident Review:"
 - All perspectives are valid.
 - Avoid counterfactuals.
 - Avoid blame.
 - Access local rationality.
