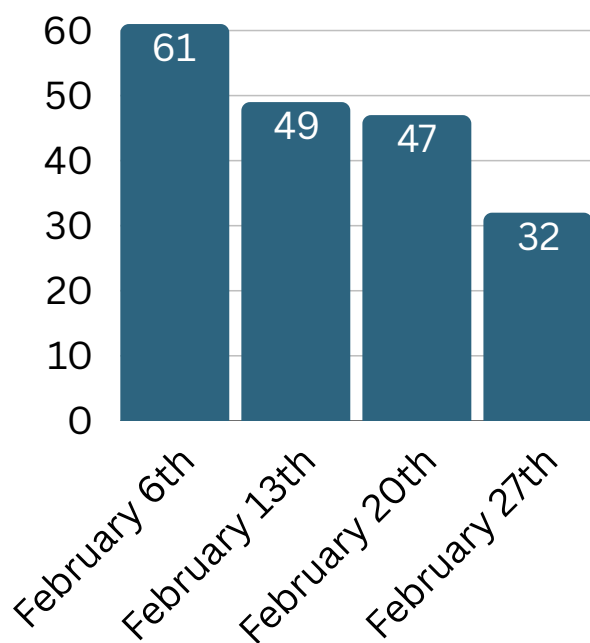

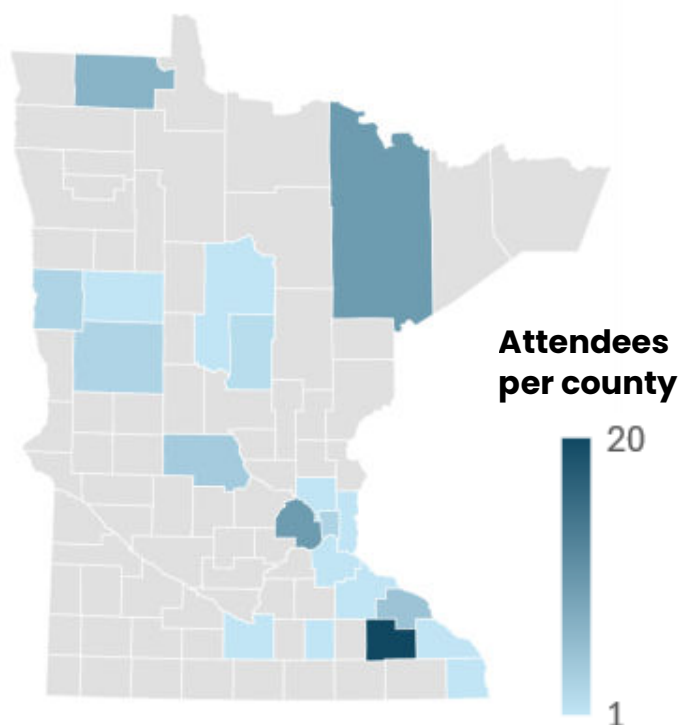

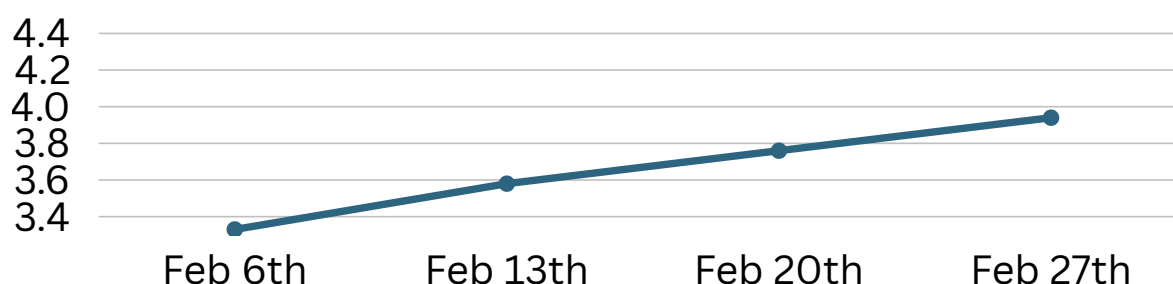
Attendance Across Minnesota
